



How to Clean Your Dog's Ears

In the Ear Canal

Begin by gently grooming around your dogs ears.

Put a small amount of appropriate ear cleaning solution into one ear and massage the base of the ear.

Let your dog shake their head to allow the softened wax to come out of the ear canal.

Use cotton balls to gently remove any solution or wax that you see. Repeat for the other ear.

CAUTION:

Do not use Q-tips in your pet's ear.

Outside the Ear

Begin by dipping a cotton ball into the appropriate ear cleaning solution.

Gently swab the inside of your dog's ear flap, Repeat for the other ear.

CAUTION:

Be careful throughout the entire process.
